Dear Jonathan,

The 22<sup>nd</sup> District Agricultural Association (District) is in receipt of your Public Records Act request dated November 9, 2011. This letter constitutes the District's final response under Government Code section 6256.

The District is authorized by law to dispose of documents after specified time periods, and under certain circumstances. Therefore, some of the records you seek may no longer be available as they have been disposed of consistent with law and the District's document retention policy

Subject to the foregoing, and to the following objections, the District will permit access to all records in the public domain, subject to the following objections.

The District will not produce documents statutorily exempt from disclosure. The District will not produce preliminary drafts, notes, intra-agency or interagency memoranda not retained in the ordinary course of business. (Govt. Code, ' 6254, subd. (a).) The District will not produce personnel, personal and private information, including medical records, medical treatment records, medical transportation records, and first aid reports. (Govt. Code, ' 6254, subd. (c); 42 U.S.C.S. ' ' 300gg - 22; Civ. Code, ' 56.10.) The District will not produce records whose disclosure is exempted or prohibited pursuant to state or federal law (Govt. Code, ' 6254, subd. (k)), including, but not limited to, documents protected by Government Code sections 6275 through 6276.48, the attorney-client privilege (Evid. Code, ' 952), minutes of closed sessions held by bodies subject to the Bagley -Keene Open Meeting Act (Gov. Code , § 11126.1), the right to privacy guaranteed by the United States and California Constitutions (California Constitution Article 1, Section 1), the deliberative process privilege, or the official information privileges. (Evid. Code, ' 1040.) Considering the above the attached is the information that you requested in your November 9, 2011 email.
